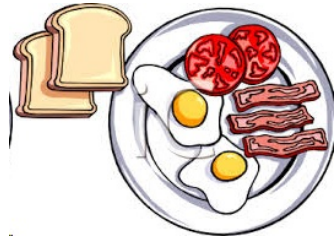


**WOW - Worship on Wednesdays**
