No activities except worship services will take place in the building.

The Session will meet September 9 to re-evaluate. (Unless positive cases within the congregation necessitate to close and have our services online.)

The Gathering Area door and one door off the sanctuary from the side parking lot will be open at 8:45 am for 9:00 am and 10:45 am for 11:00 am service. We will continue to live stream the service. We encourage anyone who isn't comfortable attending in person to continue to participate in worship from their home.


Masks are highly recommended. Hand sanitizer will be available along with paper masks (for one-time use). Cleaning will take place between the services.

There will be no handshaking, no nursery available, no congregational singing. The bathrooms will only be for emergency use and then only one person at a time. 
We want to keep all of our church family safe. Pray for each other during these uncertain times.
