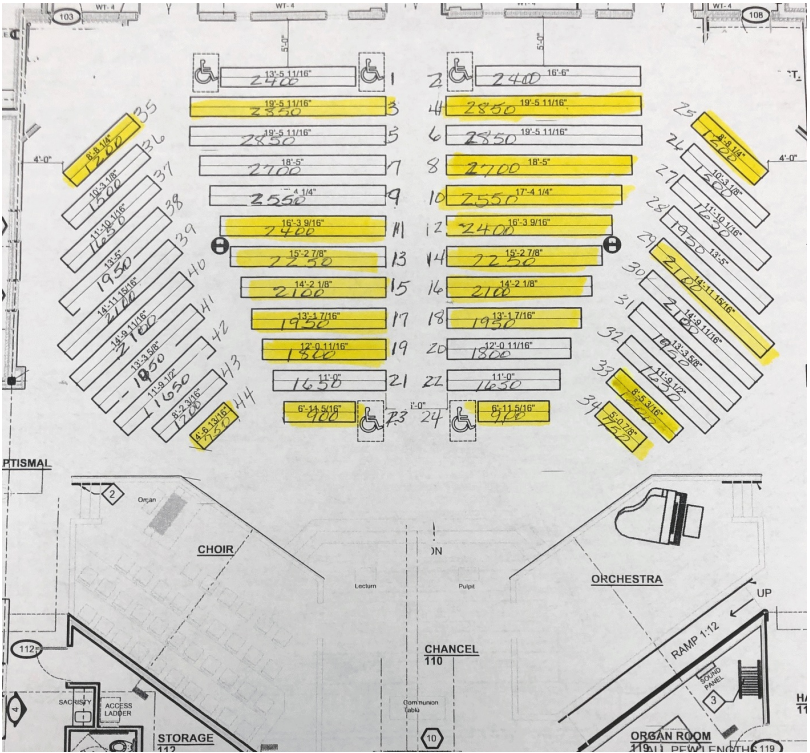
Snack Sticks for Sale
